



A Murderous Affair

HOW TO PLAY THE MURDER GAME

1. The evening starts at 6pm sharp and finishes after the Inspector's summing up at around 10.30pm. The cast will remain in character the entire time, so no matter what or when you interrogate them, they will be available for questioning
2. A Police Incident Room will be set up when there has been a murder. Clues and the suspect's motivations will be displayed throughout the evening. If you normally wear glasses to read please bring them with you. You may also like to bring a notebook and pen and maybe a magnifying glass of your own if you sometimes have difficulty with small print.
3. You will be able to put together the important and often subtle clues, some of which may be red herrings, to discover the murder plot. You can interrogate the suspects and even bring pieces of evidence to their attention that may spark an argument between them. In fact please do this as it adds to the fun!
4. Eavesdrop on all the conversations, whispered or otherwise, between the suspects. Don't forget that when you question them, they will lie through their teeth to try to protect themselves and the ones they love. Don't spare their feelings. Interrogate them to within an inch of their lives whatever their emotional state!
5. Obviously, during the evening, murders will be committed. We do our best to make the murders as realistic as possible; however we can't be one hundred percent accurate all of the time. So please accept the Police Officer's explanation of the crimes and injuries and we would ask that you don't touch the deceased as you may contaminate the evidence and puts the actors in a compromising situation.
6. The Police will be constantly updating the evidence throughout the evening and you will be encouraged to go to the incident room when new information has been added. However, the Police are not there to solve the crimes for you. That's up to you! They will be evasive about how they obtained the information unless it is essential to the plot.
7. There is only one solution to the plot. Even if you think there may be an alternative outcome. If you discover all the details you will win!
8. This plot will run for approximately six months. If you know someone who is coming to an event during this time, please don't tell them the ending or put details about the plot on social media. Feel free to take photos of your own groups and send them to us so that we can put them on our website, but please do not post photos of the dead bodies or the actors on social media.
9. We have a minimum age limit of 18. Some of our plots may have contentious issues to give the suspects gritty and realistic motives for murder. We may express controversial opinions, from time to time, but please be assured that these views are not those that are expressed by the writers or actors and that we try not to offend.
10. Main rule of the night is TO PLEASE HAVE FUN!
